Eligibility:

PMP Eligibility Overview

- To apply for the PMP, you need to have either:
- A secondary degree (high school diploma, associate's degree, or the global equivalent) with at least five years of project management experience, with 7,500 hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education.
- OR
- A four-year degree (bachelor's degree or the global equivalent) and at least three years of project management experience, with 4,500 hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education.
- This is an overview of the requirements. For complete details regarding the PMP eligibility requirements, please view the PMP Handbook for further details.
- If you do not meet the PMP eligibility requirements, you may want to look at the Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM)[®] certification.

Certification:

- The PMP examination is comprised of 200 multiple-choice questions. Of the 200 questions, 25 are considered pretest questions. Pretest questions do not affect the score and are used in examinations as an effective and legitimate way to test the validity of future examination questions. All questions are randomly placed throughout the examination.

- Computer-based testing (CBT) is the standard method of administration for PMI examinations. Paper-based testing (PBT) is available under limited circumstances (refer to the Examination Administration section in this handbook for more details).
- The allotted time to complete the computer-based examination is four hours. It may take some candidates less than the allotted four hours to complete the examination.
- There are no scheduled breaks during the exam, although you are allowed to take a break if needed.
- If you take a break during the exam, your exam clock continues to count down. The examination is preceded by a tutorial and followed by a survey, both of which are optional and both of which can take up to 15 minutes to complete. The time used to complete the tutorial and survey is not included in the examination time of four hours.
